HOW TO PARTICIPATE

Engraved bricks may pay tribute to individuals, families, clubs, organizations and companies that hold a special place in the heart of this community. They will serve as a lasting reminder of your generosity and interest in the history of Sister Bay.

Just fill out the attached order form,
clearly printing desired names in BLOCK
LETTERS.

- Standard bricks are 4x8" and can be engraved with up to three lines with a maximum of 14 letters or spaces each.
- 8x8" bricks, suitable for family groups and organizations can be engraved with up to six lines of type.
- 12x12" bricks, suitable for businesses and organizations are also available by special order. They will accommodate nine lines of 21 characters each, and a logo may be added.

Bricks must be ordered from the supplier in batches, so your request will be held until a suitable number of orders are accumulated. Placement of each brick will be at the discretion of the Sister Bay Historical Society.
