Docent/Tour Guide - Docents provide tours Tuesday through Friday from 11 am to 3 pm during the summer months when the museum is open - typically mid June to mid October. Each docent volunteer usually has a shift one day a week, not necessarily every week. Training with a written script is provided.

Baking for Various Events - Whether it's an occasional plate of cookies or bars for one of our programs, or making bigger batches for Christkindlmarkt, we can always use more bakers!

Communications and/or Graphic Design - A range of possibilities exist: proofreading, drafting membership communications, writing all or part of grant requests, making changes to our website, working on social media posts, or helping with presentations. Many of these things can be done remotely from home.

Painting, Repairs and Maintenance - Every Monday a work crew gathers at the Corner of the Past Museum to make basic repairs or complete various construction projects. Whether your skill is painting, carpentry, electrical work, or just little DIY projects, we would be glad to have you. Once you're oriented to the property and the projects, you can also work on your own on other days if that suits you better.

Open Aire Market- (Saturday mornings) - We can always use help setting up the SBHS table, and staffing it from 9 am to 1 pm on Saturdays during the summer and fall months. This simply means greeting people and transacting sales of our SBHS products, or products being sold on consignment.

Children's Programs - We host various children's programs, including field trips to our museum grounds,, summertime hands-on programs, or expanded activities during the Open Aire Market. Retired school teachers, homeschooling parents, youth leaders, or grandparents who like to teach or read to kids ... we're looking for you!

Spring Cleaning - Our annual spring cleaning occurs in May. This involves cleaning/dusting the buildings on the Corner of the Past grounds, including the Anderson House.

Christkindlmarkt (Nov-Dec) Support - We need approximately 100 volunteers for this event, and it's no surprise that many volunteer year after year. The fun includes selling drinks in the SBHS drinks hut, selling bakery or SBHS products in the Anderson House, staffing our Cherry Pie Shop, greeting visitors on the buses, or helping direct cars in the parking lot.
