Volunteer Opportunities — Sister Bay Historical Society

For all of the following volunteer activities, you get to work with fun people, and work as little or as much as you want. If you try out an activity, and it doesn't work for you, no problem ... there are no long-term commitments.

Archive Records

We're consolidating the records of all of our donated artifacts into a single document, and need help reviewing our collections, and making data entries. Spreadsheet experience is not required, but if you have that, it's a bonus.

Communications Work

There is a range of possibilities, depending on your skills and interest: proofreading, drafting membership communications, writing all or part of grant requests, making changes to our website, working on social media posts, helping with presentations. You could do one of these things, or a combination of them, depending on your skills, interest and available time.

Repair and Construction Work

Every Monday a work crew gathers at the Corner of the Past to make basic repairs and do various construction projects. Whether your skill is carpentry, electrical work, or just little DIY projects, we would be glad to have you. Once you're oriented to the property and the projects, you can also work on your own on other days if that suits you better.

Farm Market

We could use help setting up the SBHS table, and staffing it from 9 to 1 on Saturdays. That simply means greeting people, and transacting sales of our SBHS products. We might also begin to take some products on consignment — bakery goods, or other food products — and we would need someone to simply staff a table and transact sales for those.

Bakers

Whether it's an occasional plate of cookies or bars for one of our programs, or making bigger batches for Christkindlmarkt, it would be great to have a bigger pool of bakers to help with this.

Children's Programs

We are fortunate to have an individual who has stepped up to lead children's programs — whether it's field trips to our museum grounds during the school year, summertime hands-on programs, or expanded activities during the Farmers Market. Retired school teachers, homeschooling parents, youth leaders, grandparents who like to teach or read to kids ... we're looking for you.

General Support for Special Events

When we have events like the Fish Boil, Ice Cream Social, or other fundraisers, we can always use extra hands to help scoop the ice cream, serve the dinners, take tickets, etc.

Christkindlmarkt

Last year we had about 100 volunteers for this event, and it's no surprise that many have volunteered year after year. It's so much fun — whether you're selling drinks in the SBHS drinks hut, selling bakery or SBHS products in the Anderson House, greeting visitors on the buses, or helping in the parking lot.
